**Who for?**

This group will be of most value to you if you are an experienced facilitator, consultant, coach or coach supervisor interested in:

- Deepening your coaching practice
- Learning to creatively 'join up' your intuition and your thinking
- Working more consciously with the psychological dynamics of coaching
- Learning through experience how to work more effectively in/ with groups and teams
- Expanding your understanding of the organisational context of coaching
- Reflecting in depth with others, learning from their experience as well as your own.

Supervisors will especially benefit from deepening their understanding of the dynamics of supervision groups. The group will be most suitable for experienced coaches and supervisors, seeking a developmental opportunity of greater depth than usual.

**How many people in the group?**

Four members and the supervisor, balancing time and attention for individual learning needs, with enough diversity for real challenge and new insights.

**Who will conduct the group?**

Christine Thornton, an experienced and qualified supervisor and group analyst, author of *Group and Team Coaching*. She established her consulting and coaching practice, Thornton Consulting, in 1990, and is a Member of the Institute of Group Analysis [M.Inst.G.A.] and the British Association for Psychoanalytic and Psychodynamic Supervision [BAPPS]; she is an invited member of the Association for Professional and Executive Coaches and Supervisors as well as the Association for Coaching [MAC].

### **What is the model and methodology of the group?**

This is a group analytic supervision group, allowing the widest possible range of ideas to be considered, and using the group to surface hidden dynamics and extend understanding of the work presented.

The format will be for each member, in turn, to talk about their work each time. If desired, there can be opportunities to experiment with a variety of styles over time, such as action learning, Balint, thematic, critical incident, and theoretical analysis.

### **When would the group meet?**

Monthly face-to-face meeting 11.00-1.00 on Tuesdays.

### **Where will the group meet?**

### **How long am I committed to?**

There is no commitment until after the one-to-one individual session. Thereafter we ask for a minimum commitment of 10 group sessions, to allow the group to develop a stable and profound learning community committed to enquiry.

### **How much will it cost?**

The initial individual session is free of cost. The supervision group costs £90.00 per session, if paid monthly, with a 5% reduction offered to members of APECS and the Association for Coaching, or those working in public services. A further 10% reduction is offered to those paying for 10 sessions in advance. With all discounts the cost is £769.50 for 10 sessions.
